 - Provides information and referral to spouses planning a teaching career www.spousestoteachers.com



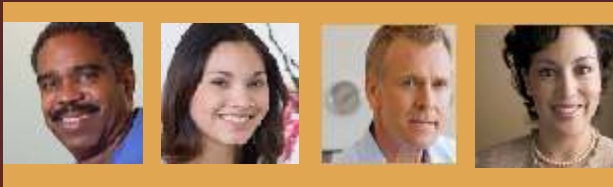
SPOUSE PREFERENCE:

Military spouses are eligible to receive employment preference when PCSing with an active duty spouse (includes active National Guard and Reserve). This preference applies worldwide to DoD appropriated fund positions as well as to some nonappropriated fund positions.

Eligibility for Spouse Preference applies to:

- Spouses of active duty members on PCS orders (Spouse must relocate to new duty station)
- Spouses of 100% disabled retired or disabled separated military members
- Unremarried widows or widowers of a military member killed on active duty
