



Family Child Care: What You Can Earn!

Family Child Care (FCC) providers can have a total of 6 children in their care including their own children. They can only have 2 children under the age of 2. Their own children over the age of 8 do not count in the total number number.

Below are two examples of potential income for an FCC Provider based on the current average weekly fees for the different age groups:

With 2 children under age 2 and 4 children over age 2 (total of 6 FCC Children, no children of your own):

\$160.00 (under 2)

With 2 of your own children (1 under age 2) and 4 FCC children over age 2:

\$160.00 (under 2)

\$150.00 (over 2)

\$610.00 per week X 4 weeks= \$2,440.00 +\$300.00 (food reimbursement) =

\$2,740.00/month or \$32,880.00/year (approximate)

This is a possible breakdown of the income you can make as a licensed Family Child Care provider. This does not include the Expanded Child Care programs you can participate in. These programs pay \$6.00/hr per child. If you do 20 hours of care per month for 2 children, you can add an additional \$240.00/month or \$2,880.00 per year.
