# FANTASY

## CONSTRUCTION:

Children build things using a variety of blocks.

## GAMES:

Children explore table games and puzzles in this area.

## MUSIC:

Children explore a variety of musical instruments and listen to music on tape or CD.

## CONVERSATION STATION:

Children can relax and socialize with their friends and listen to music softly.
