# Drop/Withdrawal Deadlines

---

Drop – a drop means that you are dropping one or more courses, but keeping at least one course for the semester. This can be completed through [Campus Connection](#). After the deadlines listed below, there is NO refund for a drop. [Instructions to Drop Courses](#).

- Thursday, August 23 → Deadline to drop an Eight Week 1 Session course and receive a 100% refund
- Wednesday, August 29 → Deadline to drop a Regular (16 week) Session course and receive a 100% refund
- Thursday, October 18 → Deadline to drop an Eight Week 2 Session course and receive a 100% refund

Withdrawal – a withdrawal means that you are dropping ALL of your courses for the semester. You *cannot* complete this in [Campus Connection](#). You must complete a [Withdrawal Form](#).
