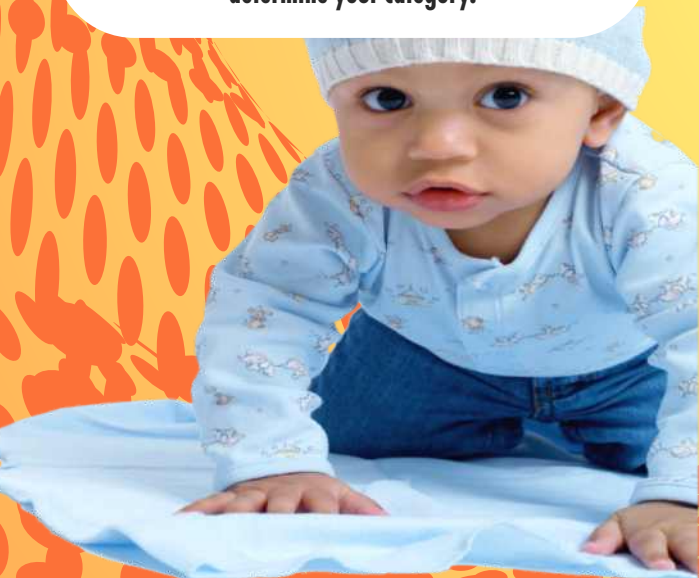


Eligibility & Participation

Children ages six weeks through age 5 before Kindergarten of any active duty military member, DOD civilians employed or supported by Minot Air Force Base, and contractors are eligible for care in the Child Development Center.

Fees

Fees for full time care are on a sliding fee schedule with nine categories and are based on total family income. To determine what care would cost for you, upon enrollment bring a copy of the military member's most recent LES and the spouse's most recent pay statement to the customer service desk of the Child Development Center and they will determine your category.

Full Time Care

The cost of hourly care is \$4.00 per hour or any part of an hour per child. Reservations are for times between the hours of 0700-1630, however children may not be dropped off between the hours of 1200-1400. Payment for hourly care is due upon pick up of your child.
