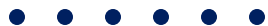

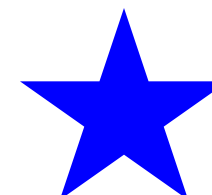
Minot AFB CPI Green Belt Training Class dates for **2019**



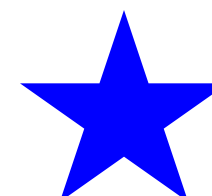

★ What is AF CPI?

CPI increases operational capabilities while reducing associated costs by applying proven techniques to all processes associated with fulfilling the AF mission.

★ What is the goal of AF CPI?

To eliminate waste while maximizing customer value.

★ How does AF CPI accomplish this goal?

By using widely accepted process improvement methodologies including Lean, Six Sigma, Theory of Constraints, and Business Process Reengineering.



How do I get started applying CPI principles?

Attend a CPI Green Belt Facilitator training class (offered monthly) conducted by the 5th Force Support Squadron Manpower Office at the Education Center.

How do I sign-up for CPI Green Belt Facilitator class?

- Complete CPI Green Belt nomination memo located on the 5 FSS/FSM [Manpower SharePoint](#) site.
- Route memo for Commander signature.
- Once signed, email memo to: 5FSS.CPI@us.af.mil.
- Once manpower receives signed memo, you'll receive confirmation email into CPI class.

Are there any pre-class readings/assignments?

One week prior to class, you'll receive an email w/all information/readings. All info can be accessed on 5 FSS/FSM [Manpower SharePoint](#) site

How do I become Green Belt certified?

*Course of Action recommended by the 5 FSS Manpower/Org Flight

Step 1: Complete CPI Green Belt academics/facilitator class.

Step 2: Attend CPI event and observe Green Belt facilitator lead the event.

Step 3: Co-facilitate a CPI event with Green Belt facilitator.

Step 4: Contact Manpower office for a certified Black Belt mentor & facilitate (solo) a CPI event with a certified Black Belt observing.

Step 6: The Black Belt mentor will then assess your project/process, documented on an A3 form, using the AF CPI evaluation rubric.

Step 7: Completed A3 submitted to MAJCOM for review/approval.
