

TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Mandatory for members separating/retiring. Must start NLT 365 days from Date of Separation/Retirement (DOS). All workshops and briefings require registration and must be completed in the following order:

- Step 1 – Complete self-assessment and supplemental questionnaire (request copy from AGFRC)
- Step 2 – Attend Initial Counseling Briefing (18-24 months from DOS)
- Step 3 – Attend Pre-Separation Briefing (NLT 365 days from DOS)
- Step 4 – Register/attend 3 day TAP Workshop (6-9 months from DOS)
- Step 5 – Register/attend 2 day Track Workshop (3-6 months from DOS)
- Step 6 – Schedule Capstone appointment – review Career Readiness Standards (NLT 90 days from DOS)

AIR FORCE AID SOCIETY (AFAS)

CAR CARE BECAUSE WE CARE

One-on-one budget appointment for oil change voucher for first term Airmen. Spouses of active duty members who are assigned to a remote tour or deployed for more than 30 days are eligible.

FALCON LOAN

An interest-free loan of \$1,000 or less for emergency. Appointment and application required.

STANDARD LOAN

An interest free loan greater than \$1,000 for emergencies.

BUNDLES FOR BABIES

A class for expectant families in the last trimester. A gift card for the BX is provided to attendees at the end of the class.

CHILD CARE PROGRAMS

PCS CARE

This program is intended to help families who are in the process of a PCS move with 20 hours child care, per child.

GIVE PARENTS A BREAK (GPAB) Child Care

Four hours of free child care once a month as scheduled at the Child Development Center or Youth Center. A referral certificate is required.

READINESS (PRE-DEPLOYMENT/REINTEGRATION)

All personnel going TDY/Remote/Deployment for more than 30 days are required to attend a Pre-Deployment Briefing. Upon return to Minot, attendance is required at a Reintegration Briefing within 7 days. Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend both briefings.
