When a military family experiences a crisis, the American Red Cross is there to help.

The military can count on the Red Cross to provide emergency communications that link them with their families during a crisis. This is done through our emergency communication center and offices across the country and around the world.

When family emergencies occur, such as the death or illness of an immediate family member, the Red Cross assists 24 hours a day, 365 days a year through our global communication network. The Red Cross sends verified reports of the emergency to the military member commander, enabling them to determine the need for the service member to return home on emergency leave. No matter where a service member or family is stationed, they can rest assured that the Red Cross will deliver their message in a time of crisis.

To assist the Red Cross, you will be asked for:

- The military member's name, rank, last four digits of their Social Security Number or date of birth, and military unit. (Complete and save Emergency Contact Card.)
- The name of the person (and their relationship to the military member) with the emergency and the nature of the situation.
- 3. The name and contact information of a medical authority to verify the emergency.
