Two world-changing events took place on a single narrow peninsula between Virginia's James and York rivers. Only a few miles from where America's first permanent English colony was planted at Jamestown 174 years later, and a new nation began.

The mission of the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation is to educate and promote understanding and awareness of Virginia's Historic Triangle, the struggles, adventures and hopes of colonial America are brought to life in vivid detail through exhibits and dramatic living history. The Foundation, accredited by the American Association of Museums, administers two living museums. Jamestown Settlement interprets the cultures of 17th century colonial Jamestown, America's first permanent English settlement, and the Powhatan Indians. Yorktown Victory Center interprets the impact of the American Revolution on the people of America and development of the nation.
