MyEval Information

MyEval 2.0 is online and is currently processing colonel evaluations. While you may not be a colonel, you should still check out myEval. You can access myEval through the myFSS website.

We encourage you to log on and make sure your myEval account is synced, and all of your supervisor information is up to date.

If your supervisor information isn't reflecting as correct, reach out to your CSS to get that information fixed.

The SRB listing was released on April 5th. SRB, or selective retention bonus, is a monetary incentive to encourage enlisted members of certain AFSCs to reenlist.

You can find more information regarding the SRB listing on myPers. (https://mypers.af.mil)

- 1. First, go to myPers, and click the blue drop-down to the left of the search bar.
- 2. Click the word "any" from the drop down options, it will be the first option.
- 3. Then in the search bar, search "PSDM 23-30" and search.
- 4. Click the link titled PSDM 23-30 (CUI) USAF FY 2023 Selective Retention Bonus Program.

That guide will have a lot of information, but the very bottom of the pages has a chart. That chart lists out all the AFSCs and the specific skill level that may be eligible for SRB.

If you have one of the AFSCs on the chart and are thinking about reenlisting, contact your CSS to see if you qualify for an SRB!
