Many programs were affected by the budget shortage, however due to some reworking of the budget, there have been some updates as to what has been affected.

PCS: For people who are PCSing, AFPC has stated that they will authenticate all orders for members going CONUS at around 30 days prior to their PDD, and about 45 days prior to the PDD for members going OCONUS.

Additionally, the MPF is no longer able to curtail a PDD for members without orders, but PDDs can be extended regardless of if the member has orders or not.

If you wish to curtail your PDD without orders, or have your orders authenticated earlier than the expected timeline, you can work with your CSS to route an ETP.

Retirements and Separations: Not much has changed regarding retirements and separations orders, but we do have more clarification. When the pause is lifted, AFPC will be prioritizing the authentication of orders by the effective date and participation in Skillbridge training programs. Orders will not be prioritized just to accommodate terminal leave since almost all retiring or separating Airmen take terminal leave.

Bonuses and Pays: Aviation bonuses, selective retention bonuses, assignment incentive pay, and foreign language proficiency bonus was restored on 21 July 2023.

AUGUST HISTORY

First Atomic Bombing

On August 6th, 1945, the first atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima. This was done by the American B-29 bomber, Enola Gay. The bomb detonated at about 1,800 feet above ground, and resulted in the death of over 105,000 people and the destruction of the city. Some time after the bombing, about 100,000 people died due to radiation.

Operation Desert Shield

Operation Desert Shield was put into effect on August 7th, 1990. The president organized a coalition of about 35 nations to defend Saudi Arabia and liberate Kuwait. The next day, the 82nd Airborne Division began to move to Saudi Arabia to build up combat power that peaked at about 600,000 US personnel.
